How to Volunteer at MSS



Studies show that children of parents who are involved in school activities are more likely to be successful. It also models Christian service and teaches children the value of giving back.

Each Morning Star family is required to complete a minimum of 15 hours of service to Morning Star School during the school year. Hours must be completed by the end of the school year. Voluntary participation beyond the 15 hours is greatly appreciated. Parents/families not serving fifteen hours will be required to pay \$5 per missing hour. Invoices will be sent home in May. Please keep track of your hours.

Please know that everything you do makes a difference and we are grateful to have your help. Parent participation is crucial to our school.

To be able to volunteer in the school you must attend the "Protecting God's Children Class and undergo a Background Screening and Live Scan Fingerprinting. Until this screening process is complete you will not be allowed to volunteer in the school. Sign up for your Protecting God's Children class soon, they fill up very quickly.

Ms. William's class created LEGO glasses which showed things that described them or are important to them. Afterwards, students shared them with the class.








JUNIOR HIGH NEWS
