### 2019-2020 Instrumental Music Program at Morning Star School

Everyone should have the opportunity to experience the joy of learning to play music. This is a fun way in which studies have shown that instrumental music directly contributes to children's intellectual development, and helps with those who may have learning challenges or differences. It is a powerful learning tool that will help aid with success in school; especially in subjects like math and reading. Our goal is to provide each student with the best possible musical experience while having fun learning.

#### **PROGRAM STRUCTURE AND EXTRAS**

Students will have semi-private lessons once per week after school on Wednesdays. Opportunities include school concerts and events from all the **MusicWorks** instrumental programs throughout the city. Some examples are a city-wide combined band concert and an awards night performance for ALL students. Piano students will also have a city-wide recital. Extra music, miscellaneous supplies and minor repairs as well as fun-related outings and field trip lunches are also included.



**OBTAINING INSTRUMENTS AND AGE REQUIREMENTS** It will be necessary to provide the student with an instrument in good playing condition. Most music stores rent band instruments for about \$20 per month including insurance, repairs, and replacements. It is not necessary to own a piano for those interested in this instrument. Electric keyboards can be purchased for about \$100. Before choosing an instrument all students will have attended a presentation of the program, an instrument demonstration, and a chance to try instruments. The instruments offered are clarinet, flute, oboe, saxophone, trumpet, French horn, trombone ,drums/percussion and piano/keyboard. Students may begin on instruments as young as nine years old.

### HOW TO SIGN UP



#### COST

Our program is the most inexpensive way to learn to play an instrument in N.E. Florida. It is only \$50 per month (far lower than the \$25-\$30 per lesson frequently charged) for the entire program. Three payment plans exist, outlined on the reverse; and if you pay by the semester or the year there are additional discounts.

All payments are non-refundable. Note: This is a tuition fee, not a per lesson charge. Absence by students will not be credited. Absence by the instructor in excess of one per semester will be credited to students in the amount of \$7.00 per day missed. Major holidays falling on established lesson days are figured into the semester schedule; others will be made up. **Returned checks will be subject to a \$20 service charge**. Payments over 15 days late are considered delinquent and the student may be suspended until payment is made in full. Year payments are due in September. Semester payments also pay in January. **A late fee of \$5.00 per month will be charged for all late payments and payment plans.** Delinquent accounts may be sent to a collection agency with a \$15 service charge. **We must be notified in writing of any discontinuation of lessons.** Lessons will be charged up until the date the notice is received.

Neither the instructor nor Morning Star School can accept responsibility for loss, theft or damage to instruments and/or equipment. The instructor and Morning Star School reserve the right to establish and change lesson days. Enrollment in the program constitutes agreement with the policies established by the instructor and Morning Star School.
