### Cold & Flu Season

Cold and flu season is upon us. The Health Department is encouraging everyone



to treat every case of the flu or respiratory illness seriously. Fortunately, we have had very few cases of flu-like illness at Morning Star.

#### AS A REMINDER...

- Keep your child home if he or she is ill with flu or flu-like symptoms for at least 24 hours after they no longer have signs of fever without the use of fever reducing medicine.
- Practice good hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette. Encourage frequent hand washing with soap and water. Teach children to cough into their elbows NOT their hands.
- Routinely clean and disinfect surfaces.

Please keep your child home if he or she is ill with flu-like symptoms. Any child who presents with flu-like symptoms or fever will be sent home. If your child falls into any high-risk category (asthma, diabetes, or other chronic illness) see your doctor immediately if they become ill. We will make any necessary accommodations to meet your child's educational needs while they are out sick.
