Choose a local, state or national park you would like to know more about.



1. Make a picture book or online slideshow about your park. Be ready to present the first day of school. If you make a slideshow, use google slides in your google classroom apps. It has to be accessible and ready to be shown the first day of school.
2. Conduct research about your park in a variety of ways including taking a virtual tour, reading online articles, viewing google images, reading a book or brochure about your park, visiting your park in person.
3. List 5 interesting facts in your own words about your park. Include 1 picture with each fact on a page or slide. Your sentences must be in your own words and not copied from a source (use correct punctuation, capitalization, organization and spelling.)
4. Make a title page. It must include the name of your park, your name, the date and an interesting picture from the park. Put in a folder to hand in the first day of school and be ready to present in class. If the slideshow is made, be ready to present it in class the first day 8/10/20.
