



Makaley Binder and Ray Carpenter secured Superior designation for the 2024 NCTE Achievement Award in Writing by the National Council of Teachers of English (NCTE)!

The NCTE Achievement Awards in Writing is a school-based writing program established in 1957 to encourage high school students to write and to recognize some of the best student writers in the nation. Only students who are juniors may participate. Schools in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, US territories, Canada, and American schools abroad can nominate students for the writing program.

Makaley is passionate about writing, visual and performance arts, reading, and animals, most notably her golden and constant companion, Corbin. Ray is actively involved in his youth group, loves writing and reading, and enjoys creating visual arts projects.

This year, schools nominated 633 students. From the United States, students were nominated from 44 states, as well as Guam and Washington, D.C. Internationally, teachers nominated students from Canada, Greece, Jordan, South Korea, Taiwan, and Thailand. Two to three independent judges evaluated each submission holistically on content, purpose, audience, tone, word choice, organization, development, and style.

Ms. Brock, the ELA teacher at MSHS, said, "Makaley's writing and collage reflected her present mindset and growth as an individual and an author. She has not only found her voice, but she is also using it, and I couldn't be more proud or excited to see what she says next. Raymond took a harrowing experience that could have broken others and turned it into something beautiful. But that's the gift of art, isn't it?"
